

CA Governor Schwarzenegger wrote in his veto message of a similar bill there: "**This measure would make it a crime for any person or entity to own or control more than 50 unsterilized adult dogs or cats for breeding or raising for sale as pets.** I support measures designed to prevent animal cruelty and that punish persons engaged in the abuse of animals. However, this measure simply goes too far in an attempt to address the serious problem of puppy mills."

California Got It Right

Missouri needs to follow this lead!

The HSUS/HSMo/Alliance Puppy Mill Initiative goes just as far:

4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, **no person may have custody of more than fifty covered dogs** for the purpose of breeding those animals and selling any offspring for use as a pet.

(1) "Covered dog" means any individual of the species of the domestic dog, *Canis lupus familiaris*, or resultant hybrids, that is over the age of six months and has intact sexual organs.
